Floral artist Michael A. Hasco is an honors graduate of Pennsylvania College of Technology with a degree in Floral Design and Interior Plantscape Design. His education includes numerous workshops and seminars with world-class international designers.

Michael's love of floral art led him to complete a yearlong internship serving as assistant display specialist at world renowned Longwood Gardens. His intern project, an Italian Christmas Tree, or "ceppo," was one of the main features during Longwood's Christmas

festivities in 2000.

In 2005, Michael was awarded the floral industry's coveted Accredited in Floral Design designation, and inducted into the American Institute of Floral Designers, (AIFD) during ceremonies at AIFD's internationally acclaimed symposium held in Seattle.

Michael continues to share his passion for design and flowers with others. He has been a guest designer and featured lecturer on numerous occasions at Penn College and presented a program on European armatures at the Philadelphia Flower Show. Locally he has represented the Pennsylvania Floral Industry Association on live TV at the Pennsylvania State Farm Show, and has conducted classes and presentations for local organizations and nonprofits. Most recently, in 2007 and 2009, he contributed his artistic abilities as a featured designer with the award winning AIFD exhibit at the Philadelphia Flower Show.
